* Students enrolled in at least 12-units in the same semester may take up to 4 audit units at no extra charge. However, Art students must be enrolled in at least 15-units in the same semester to take up to 4 audit units at no extra charge. Students enrolled in Doctoral Study may take 1 audit class for no charge. The class can be worth 2 or 4 audit units.

** Executive Management courses may not be audited. Audit fees apply to all other non-Executive Management courses.

*** Alumni are defined as graduates of Claremont Graduate University who are not currently enrolled and seeking another CGU degree. Instructor approval is required to audit. Audit fees are not connected to the program from which the alum graduated and tuition discounts for more than 12-units do not apply. Alumni can only receive a 50% discount on standard tuition rates; not for classes which have a flat rate.

NOTE: Tuition rates for dual degree students are based on the higher rate of the two programs, regardless of the subject or number of enrolled units. Students are considered dual degree for the duration of their careers, which culminates in the granting of both degrees.
